**1. FINANCING OF PROJECTS**

**2. Recovery Of Funds**

- Ushs. 17.195 bn has been recovered representing 67% of the amount due [Ushs. 25.847]
- **162** groups have made up 100% recoveries
- Ushs. **13.851** bn [82%] of what has been recovered has been remitted to BoU central recovery account

- UGX. **7.956** bn has been revolved back to the respective Local governments
- **897** Projects have been funded using revolving funds

### KAMAYIBA YOUTH MAKE A LIVING FROM HAND CRAFTS -KASESE MUNICIPALITY

The project is located in Kamayiba Town Council, Kasese Municipal Council. The group is composed of 11 members, 9 female and 2 male.

The group received UGX. 8,000,000 in August, 2017 to invest in the making of hand crafts. The group has so far recovered USHs1,500,000 as at the end of April 2018, and still on track of recovering the outstanding loan amount.

#### Key Benefits

- The project has enabled member acquire skills in art and craft. The members themselves are involved in making beaded scarfs, traditional wear, weaving of baskets used at traditional functions.
- They have so far trained 10 members of the community in making crafts.
- The project has provided market to the locals for materials used in making crafts such as beads
- The project has helped members learn a saving culture and at the moment have a group SACCO where each member saves USHs10,000 per month.
- As a result of the project, members have been provided direct employment opportunities and this has enabled them enhance their incomes and standard of living.
